ESOL at Glasgow Museums

1.5 hours, free of charge

Students will enjoy interactive tours of the collections and take part in practical activities which aim to develop written and spoken language skills.

These facilitated sessions are ideal for those at an intermediate or advanced level.

Session content will vary according to the venue visited. If you have a particular theme or interest, we may be able to accommodate this.

Support for Learning Programme

1.5 hour, free of charge

A hands-on session where students will explore museum collections through group work and practical activities, while developing skills for learning, life and work.

Themes and topics vary depending on venue and include:

- Pop-art Printing at GoMA
- Expressions & Emotions or Ancient Egypt at Kelvingrove Museum
- Nature in Art & Design at The Burrell Collection
- World Religions at St Mungo Museum
- Romans at GMRC
- Transport & technology themes at Riverside Museum
- Tailored sessions based on the social history collections stored at Kelvin Hall
